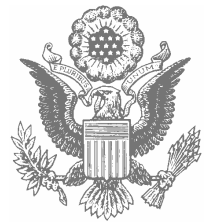


Congressman David G. Valadao

United States Service Academy Application for Nomination



SUBMISSION DEADLINE: October 30, 2026

Congressman Valadao is honored to nominate students living in California's 22nd Congressional District to attend a United States service academy.

To be considered for a nomination, you must submit a complete application packet to Congressman Valadao's office including:

- A nomination application
- A copy of your high school transcript, including your GPA, class size, and class rank
- If in college, a copy of your college transcript
- An official copy of your SAT or ACT scores
(If you haven't taken a test or received results by 10/30, please notify us prior to submitting your application)
- A resume
- Two letters of recommendation. At least one letter must be from a teacher, principal, or school counselor. Recommenders cannot be family, and should speak to your character, leadership, and academic ability.

You are encouraged to apply for a nomination from every nomination source you are eligible for, including:

- Congressman David Valadao
- Senator Adam Schiff
- Senator Alex Padilla
- President Donald Trump, who nominates children of career military personnel; deceased or disabled veterans; military or civilian personnel in missing status; and Medal of Honor recipients
- Vice President JD Vance, who nominates five individuals from across the U.S. per year
- The Secretary of the Army, Navy, or Air Force, who nominates members of regular military, reserve components, and participants in ROTC

Nomination Timeline:

- June 1 – Nomination application opens
- October 30 – Nomination application deadline
- Mid-November – Interview with nomination committee
- December – Nominations announced
