Re: Community Project Funding Request for the Kaweah Siphon Resiliency Project.

Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Avenal Water Storage Tank Project in Fiscal Year 2025.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Avenal, located at 919 Skyline Blvd, Avenal, CA 93204.

The funding will be used by the City of Avenal to purchase a replacement five million gallon water storage tank that they solely rely upon for clean and safe drinking water, as well as wastewater treatment purposes. The existing 52-year-old, 2.8-million gallon water tank sits atop the Avenal Rolling Hills and has long surpassed its expected lifespan of 30 years, now showing signs of denting and heavy rusting of its interior coating. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds as it will ensure that the city's population of 14,000 will have reliable access to clean and safe drinking water, which they solely rely upon for their gravity-fed surface water supply via the California Aqueduct.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq.
