Re: Hanford Industrial Park Water Transmission Project

Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Hanford Industrial Park Water Transmission Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Hanford located at 315 North Douty Street Hanford, CA 93230.

The funding would be used to strengthen the resiliency of the city water system by creating a new water transmission line that would provide a second connection to the city's main industrial park, and for the first time connect the unincorporated community of Home Garden to the municipal water system. The project would expand the municipal city's water grid and increase the pressure of the municipal system, which is beneficial for water quality and firefighting. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will help the City expand drinking water availability to their residents and increase the system's capacity in the event of an emergency.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
