I am requesting funding for the Wasco Downtown Revitalization Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Wasco, located at 746 8th Street, Wasco, CA 93280.

The funding would be used to improve portions of Wasco, CA encompassing 7th Street from G Street to D Street. The project would revive the downtown area by providing infrastructure including road and alley reconstruction, sidewalks and gutters, ADA accessibility, lighting, trash enclosures, and water main improvements. The project is part of the city's efforts to advance economic vitality and create a more vibrant downtown district where businesses and the community can thrive. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will increase the use of active transportation, improve safety, and invest in small businesses in a rural, underserved community, which will encourage job creation, local shopping, and community pride.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized in 23 USC 133(b) (Surface Transportation Block Grant Program).
