Dear Chair DeLauro and Ranking Member Granger:

I am requesting funding for the City of Sanger Veterans Park in fiscal year 2022. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Sanger, located at 1700 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Sanger, CA 93657.

The funding would be used to complete Phase II of the Veterans Memorial Park in Sanger, CA. This community park will feature walking paths, lighted sports fields, a pavilion, and a Veterans Memorial Monument. The community athletic fields will be available to local sports teams for practice and play and will serve as a stormwater storage basin to further maximize the use of green space. The park will provide a multigenerational gathering place and recreational facility for socioeconomically disadvantaged households and provide athletic opportunities for youth. Residents will be able to stay local for their sports and recreation interests, and athletes and teams visiting the park will increase purchases made from businesses within the City of Sanger, strengthening the local economy. This project will create jobs, improve social equity, and promote health and wellness within the Sanger community.
